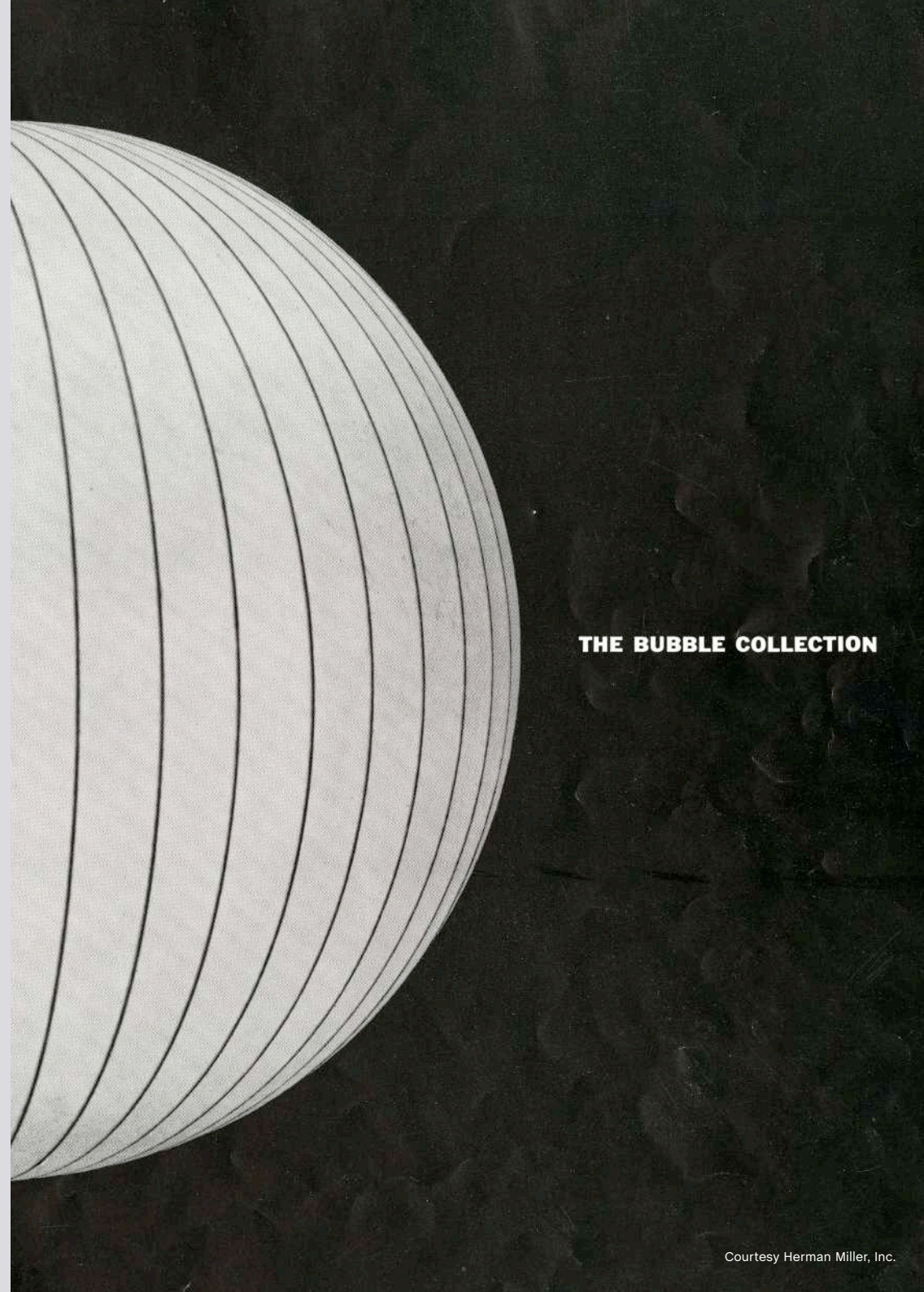

At the same time that it represents a moment of pure revolution from Modernism's heyday, it also brings a sense of heritage and history that anchors the collection.

HAY will distribute Bubble Lamp in both pendant- and wall-lamp styles and an assortment of sizes and shapes, enabling our customers to enjoy the soft glow of Nelson's revolutionary design in their own homes.



THE BUBBLE LAMP IN CONTEXT

Designed by pioneering American designer George Nelson in 1947, and first produced in 1952, the Bubble lamp signaled a revolution in the Modernist lighting industry. Available in an assortment of organic sizes and shapes, these elegant orbs were inspired by a set of silk-covered Swedish pendant lamps Nelson wanted for his office, but found to be too expensive. Employing the resourcefulness that characterized his working process, he decided to use a self-webbing plastic spray developed by the U.S. military, and applied it over a lightweight, rounded-steel frame to produce these soft, glowing fixtures.

MEET GEORGE NELSON

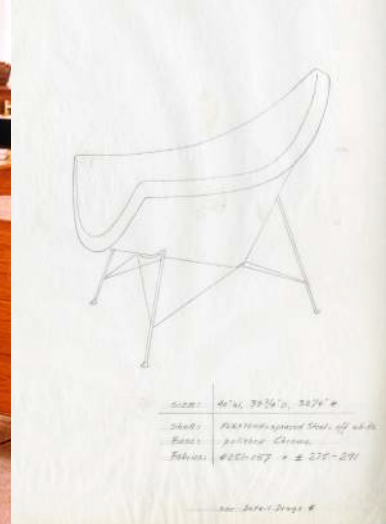
“Design is a response to social change.”

Born in Connecticut, USA, George Nelson (1908-1986) was one of the most influential figures in the crucial early period of modern design. Trained at Yale as an architect and a fine artist, he believed that a designer's job was to better the world, using the perfection of nature's creations as his guide. Two formative years in Rome following his receipt of the prestigious Rome Prize brought him into contact with the world's leading modernists, including Le Corbusier, Mies Van der Rohe, Walter Gropius, Gio Ponti, and many others, and helped shape his career as a writer and industrial designer, who would change the course of history.

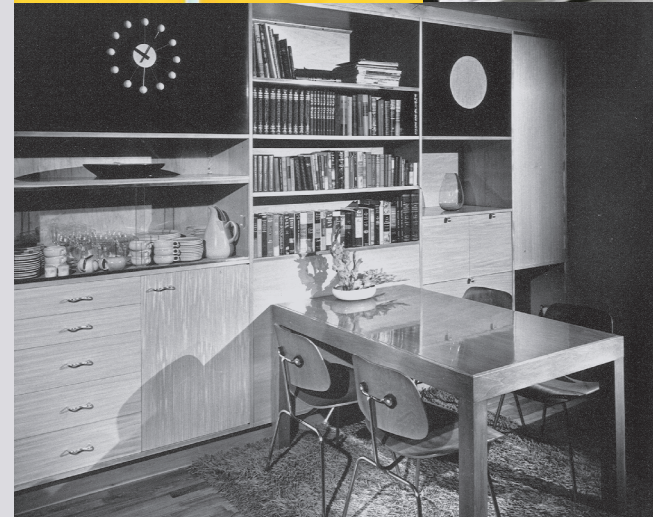
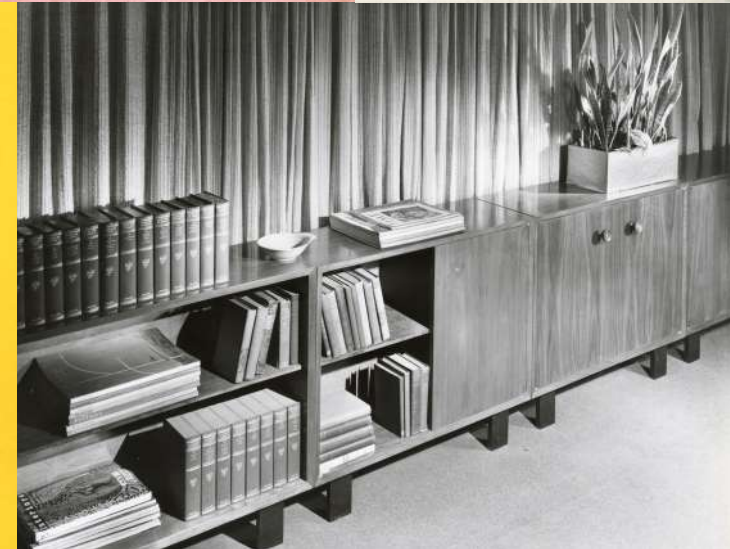

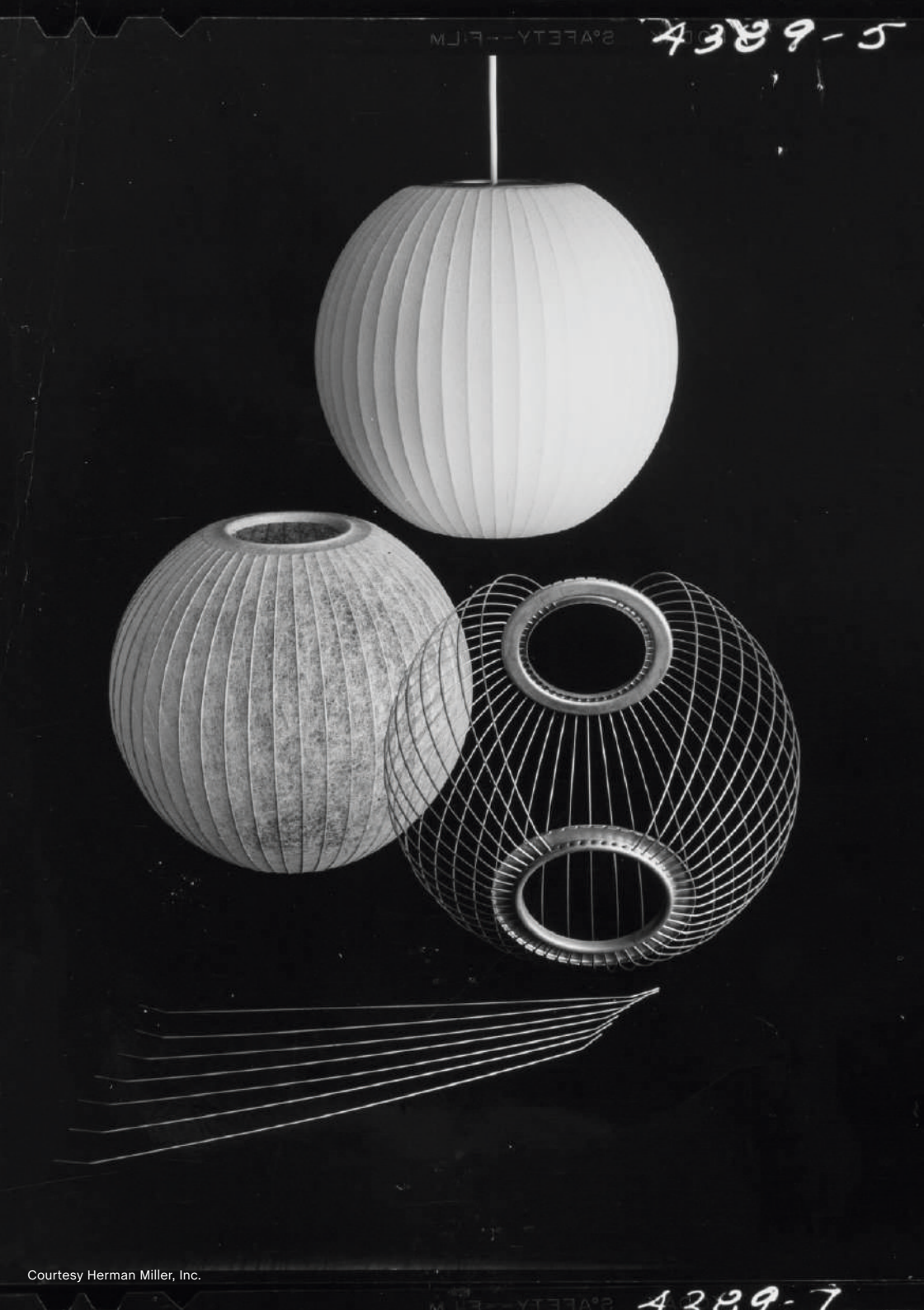


GEORGE NELSON'S LEGACY

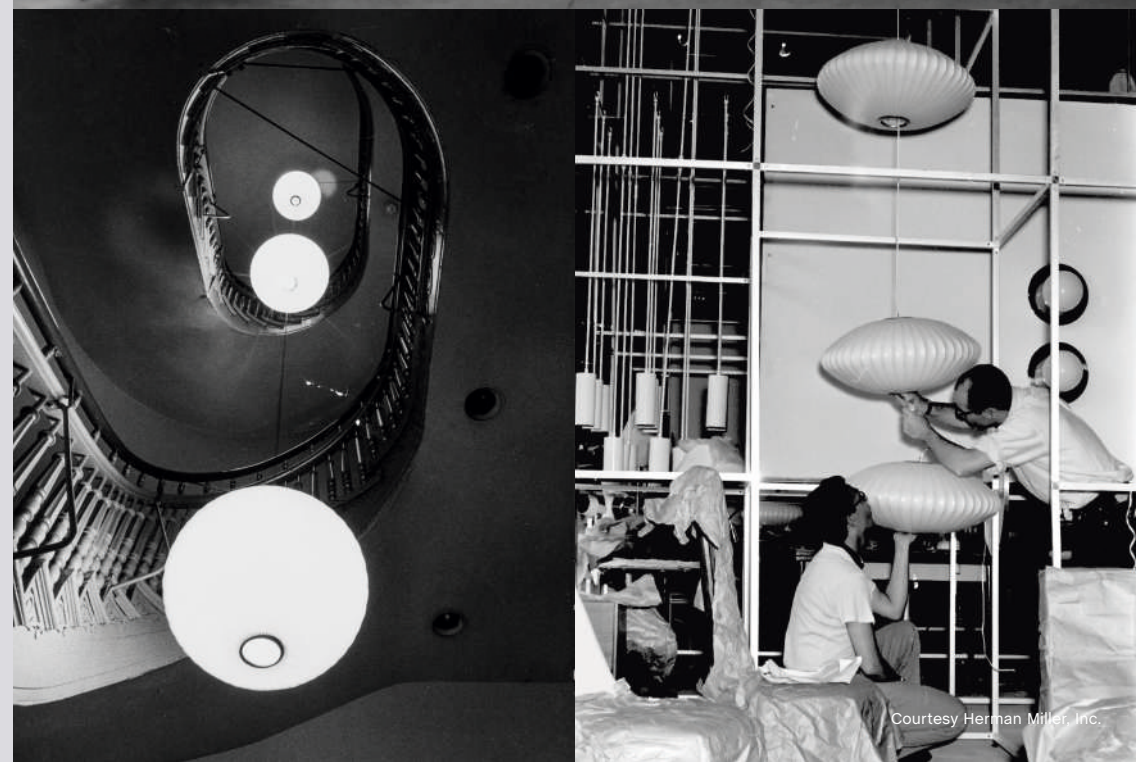
"It was important to me to have certain status symbols around, and one of the symbols was a spherical hanging lamp made in Sweden. It had a silk covering that was very difficult to make.... But I wanted one badly"

"....Suddenly an image popped into my mind.... It was a picture in the NYT some weeks before which showed Liberty ships being mothballed by having the decks covered with netting and then being sprayed with a self-webbing plastic.... Whammo! We rushed back to the office and made a roughly spherical frame; we called various places until we located the manufacturer of the spiderwebby frame. By the next night we had a plastic-covered lamp and when you put a light in it, it glowed and it did not cost \$125."

PRODUCTION

All Bubble Lamp models are produced in the same American factory that originally developed them in the 1950s. The Bubble Lamp is produced in several shapes, including the classic spherical ball shape and an elongated oval shape. Each model has a steel-wire skeleton on the interior, which is spray coated with the translucent plastic polymer Nelson first encountered in that 1947 photograph of U.S. military ships, resulting in a lamp, that is both opaque and transparent as it glows. Bubble Lamps are available from HAY in pendant- and wall-lamp styles.

- MATERIALS -

All Bubble Lamp models have a steel-wire skeleton on the interior which is spray coated with the translucent plastic polymer resulting in a lamp that is both opaque and transparent as it glows.

SHADE / Webbing polymer

COLOUR / Off white

FRAME TOP & BOTTOM RING / Coated and brushed metal and nickel

CABLE / White PVC isolation. L183 cm

LIGHT SOURCE TYPE / E27 (not included)

NELSON BUBBLE WALL SCONCE

Sconce comes in 4 unique bubble styles: Ball, Cigar, Pear and Saucer

SHADE / Webbing polymer

COLOUR / Off white

FRAME TOP & BOTTOM RING / Coated and brushed metal and nickel

WALL BRACKET / Walnut

ARM / Brushed-nickel steel arm that extends approximately 36 cm

CABLE / White PVC isolation. L366 cm

LIGHT SOURCE TYPE / E27 (not included)

MOVEMENT / Sconce arm has a swivel hinge and adjustable 366 cm long plug-in cord with a counterweight, allowing for height adjustment from left-to-right, and up-and-down, without having to change its position on the wall

NELSON TRIPLE BUBBLE LAMP FIXTURE

Fixture-Triple Lamp Fixture is sold separately from Bubble lamp pendants and cords. Distance between metal rods and walnut balls is 36,83 cm

Pendants should not exceed 48,26 cm in diameter

Holds 3 small Bubble Pendants

CEILING ROSE / Brushed nickel-plated steel measuring 13,33 cm

BALLS / Walnut

RODS / Metal

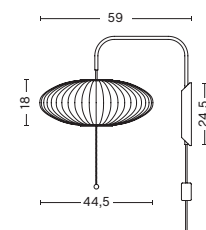
